Job Purpose

The Technical Engineer will primarily take responsibility for electrical, mechanical and plant asset care of land-based plant and equipment. They will help initiate continuous improvement, RCA and proactive preventative maintenance. The job holder will also be responsible for developing the PPMs to minimise downtime and supporting CAPEX projects to support the sites. Whilst primarily based at Langass or Geocrab there might be occasional travel to other sites and some mechanical work is to be expected.

- Structured and practical electrical engineering training e.g. apprenticeship/HNC
- Experience of working with electrical / mechanical systems.
- Sound understanding of BS7671 & IET Wiring Regs.
- Flexibility to provide cover for sites
- Knowledge and experience of Generators, compressors, boat engines, electrical systems
- Knowledge of IT systems and CMMS systems
- Ability to work in a safe manner and considers the safety of others
- A strong team player as well as the ability to work on your own initiative
- Proven ability to work under pressure/to deadlines
- Aware of importance of environmental issues

- Strong background mechanical plant and equipment

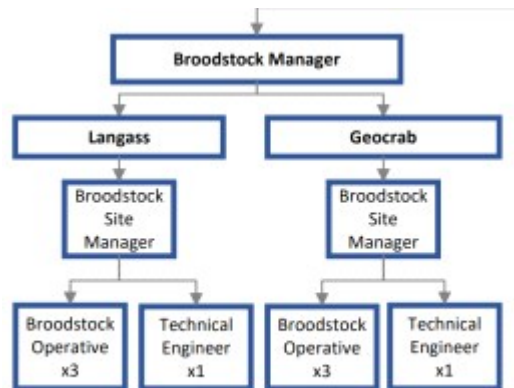
Person Specification - Preferable

- Fully accountable for all maintenance and servicing on site.
- Accountable for tracking engineering issues and accurately reporting cause and actions to close out.
- Compile weekly reports and send to the Engineering Manager.
- Ensure departmental compliance with all Health and Safety and technical requirements.
- Assist the Engineering Manager in the creation of an asset register to drive future capex.
- Background and experience in automation and an understanding in machine networks would be an advantage.
- Required to assist with on site rotas and weekend call-outs.
- Supervision of external contractors where applicable
- Maintains all site equipment to a high operational standard.
- Required to carry out ad-hoc operational roles as directed by the Site Manager
